<p>➤ Case n°1 : Ukrainian national residing in Ukraine before 24 February 2022 who left Ukraine from 24 February (or after, or present on that date in a Member State of EU)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Nationality proof : valid or expired passport within the last two years, or valid or expired national identity card, or consular certificate ✓ Copy of the Schengen entry stamp (or in the absence of stamp, any supporting document attesting a mouvement outside Ukraine, including travel proof) ; ✓ Copy of Schengen visa (if non-biometric passport) or stamped travel document.
<p>➤ Case n°2 : Stateless persons or nationals of another state other than Ukraine who have been granted international protection or equivalent national protection in Ukraine before 24 February</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Proof of civil status: National identity card, passport, or any other document proving civil status (family record book, etc.) ; ✓ Copy of the title granting international or national protection in Ukraine ✓ Copy of the Schengen entry stamp (or in the absence of stamp, any supporting document attesting a mouvement outside Ukraine, including travel proof)
